### **Terms of Use**

### 1. Acceptance of Terms

If you do not agree with any part of these terms, you may not use our facilities or services. The Film Foundry reserves the right to update or modify these terms at any time without prior notice.

### 2. Facility Use & Rental Policies

- Rentals must be scheduled in advance and are subject to availability.
- The person or organization booking the space is responsible for any damages that occur during their rental period.
- All renters must adhere to The Film Foundry's policies and guidelines while using the facility.
- The Film Foundry reserves the right to deny or terminate a rental if policies are not followed.

### 3. Payments & Cancellations

- All rental fees must be paid in full before the start of the rental period unless otherwise agreed upon.
- Cancellations made within 48 hours of the scheduled rental may be subject to a cancellation fee.
- Refunds will not be issued for no-shows or cancellations made on the day of the event.

### 4. Liability & Safety

- The Film Foundry is not responsible for any lost, stolen, or damaged personal property.
- Renters and guests assume all risks associated with using our facilities, including but not limited to personal injury.
- Users of our space must comply with all local laws, fire codes, and safety regulations.

### 5. Equipment & Space Use
